TITLE IX POLICY STATEMENT:

LeMoyne-Owen College (LOC) complies with the requirements of Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, which prohibits discrimination on the basis of sex in all programs and activities receiving federal financial assistance. It is the policy of LOC to prohibit discrimination and harassment on the basis of race, color, national origin, ancestry, religion, sex, sexual orientation including gender identity, marital status, civil union status, age, physical or mental disability, military status, or unfavorable discharge from military service in regard to the administration of educational programs, admission of students, employment actions, athletics or other sponsored activities.

To ensure compliance with Title IX, LOC has designated Title IX coordinators who are responsible for developing, adopting and making this policy available to the LOC community. The Title IX coordinators will facilitate LOC's Title IX compliance and response to inquiries, as well as coordinate Title IX compliance requirements with the Department of Athletics and other college departments, as appropriate.
