Two LeMoyne-Owen college students have been awarded scholarships from the UNCF.

Raven Grandberry, a business management major and LOC's reigning Miss UNCF, received a UNCF/Koch Scholars Program award. The program "is designed to teach students how to develop and apply an entrepreneurial mindset by exploring how the study of entrepreneurship, innovation and economics contribute to well-being for individuals, communities and societies."

Students may receive up to \$2,500 a semester in scholarship awards for up to four years totaling up to \$20,000 in scholarship awards.

As part of receiving the scholarship, Grandberry will attend a business leadership conference in the nation's capital in April.

Elisha Jewell received a \$4,000 UNCF Elmer Roe Deaver Foundation Scholarship. She is a member of LOC's W.E.B. Du Bois Scholars Program.
