POSITION OVERVIEW

The Assistant Professor of Computer Science is a teaching and research faculty position. The position will serve primarily as a cybersecurity instructor and researcher. (75% instruction and 25% research) for the Center for Cybersecurity. This position will be a tenure track position. This position will increase research efforts and provide a place where criminal justice, education, and computer science students can collaborate on research projects.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Teach 75% courses and 25% research. The successful candidate should be able to teach most of the core courses in the computer science and cybersecurity curriculum as well as being able to offer upper-level elective courses. The normal load is 12 hours per semester
- Show evidence of continued professional development
- Advise students
- Perform research
- Participate in department and college service activities

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Ph.D. credentialed to teach Computer Science at the college level
- Commitment to excellence in undergraduate computer science education and research
- Teaching experience preferred
