The Part-time (Adjunct) Faculty will be required to teach less than 12-credit hours per semester during alternate traditional daytime schedule as well as during the evening. Will play a pivotal role in advancing the institution's academic mission through teaching. Contribute to the intellectual growth and development of students. The teaching focus will be on introductory and advanced level Health & Fitness/Wellness course work.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Teach a range of content, methods, and theoretical application related to Health and Fitness/Wellness courses.
- Assist in monitoring student performance in their academic and professional progress.
- Assessing student performance through exams, assignments, and other forms of testing.

Minimum Qualifications

- Master's degree in health fitness or related disciplines.

- Ability to work effectively with faculty members.
- Ability to work effectively with different constituencies.
- Understanding of the goals and practices of active, experiential community-based education.
- Ability to use electronic resources in developing course materials, reports, and tracking students.
